



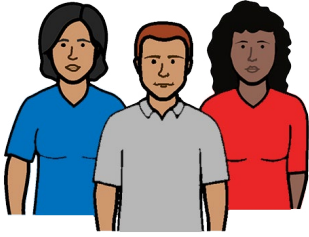

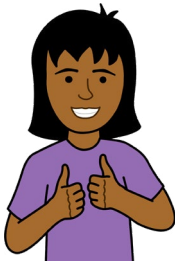


This book is from the Victorian Disability Worker Commission and the Disability Worker Registration Board of Victoria.

- make sure services for people with disability are safe and of good quality.



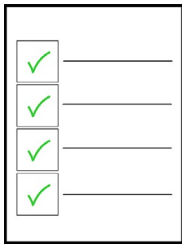
## About this book

- closes 13 December 2024.



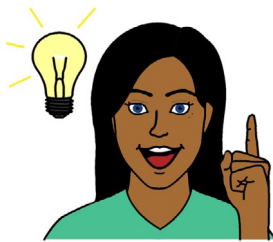

## About our registration standards books

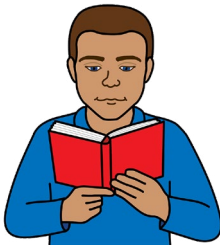


We wrote easy to read books about our 3 registration standards.

## About our survey



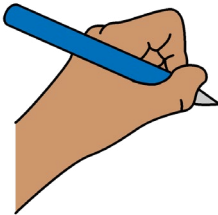
We wrote an easy to read survey.

You can write your answers on the easy to read survey.

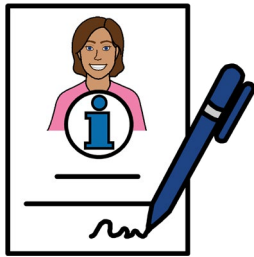

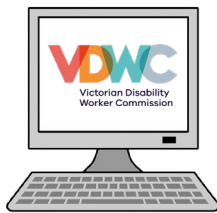

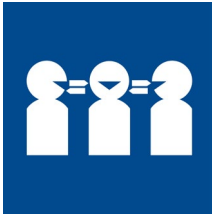
