## Disability Service Safeguards Act 2018 Section 130

This Interim Prohibition Order is made pursuant to section 130 of the *Disability Service Safeguards Act 2018*.

An Interim Prohibition Order can remain in force for up to 12 weeks. This Interim Prohibition Order will remain in force for 12 weeks from the date it takes effect and will expire at 11:59pm on Monday, 14 April 2025 unless it is revoked before that date.
The unregistered disability worker is:
Prohibited from providing all disability services in Victoria.  Under section 3 of the Disability Service Safeguards Act 2018, a disability service means—  (a) a service (other than a prescribed exempt service) which involves more than incidental contact with a person with a disability and is specifically provided to the person for the principal purpose of caring for, or treating, the person or supporting the person to manage the person's limitations in undertaking one or more of the following activities—  (i) communication;  (ii) social or economic participation;  (iii) social interaction;  (iv) learning;  (v) mobility;  (vi) self-care;  (vii) self-management; or  (b) a prescribed service;

In this Interim Prohibition Order 'unregistered disability worker' and 'disability service' have the same meaning as in section 3 of the *Disability Service Safeguards Act 2018*.

This Interim Prohibition Order takes effect on the date specified in the Order.

This Interim Prohibition Order will be published in the Victoria Government Gazette and on the Internet site of the Victorian Disability Worker Commission, <a href="https://www.vdwc.vic.gov.au">www.vdwc.vic.gov.au</a>.

Contravention of an Interim Prohibition Order is an offence under the *Disability Service Safeguards Act 2018*.
